One suggestion is to perhaps consider adding a front door camera (Ring, Google, etc.) if you haven't already outside your unit front door. You can check with our Property Manager Penny Blackwood at 818-240-6515 for the HOA's guidelines on Front Door Cameras on where they can be placed. Having a camera helps to ensure safety for your unit in detouring thieves away.

Another home safety suggestion might be to consider a home security monitoring system for your unit.
